

Roof Inspection Supply List

Extension Ladder An extension ladder is crucial to safely access and inspect your roof.

- 

Gloves Roof shingles feel like sandpaper, so make sure to have a good pair of gloves available.

- 

or

Safety Glasses or Goggles Safety glasses are great eye protection if you do not wear corrective eyeglasses. If you do wear corrective eyeglasses, you will need protective goggles instead of protective glasses.

or

Mask or Ventilator If your attic is clean, a lightweight mask should be fine for inspecting the attic. If your attic has not been inspected in a while and/or has dust, we recommend a ventilator with a filter instead.

Protective Suit for Attic We recommend a Protective Suit for going in your attic. This will keep your clothes clean.

- 

Werner Roofing Safety System This safety system kit includes a harness, lanyard, and roof anchor so that you can feel secure scaling up your roof.

- 

Moss-B-Ware If you have a problem with moss on your roof, Moss-B-Ware should be at the top of your supply list.

- 

Push Broom This is a good broom to remove moss without damaging the roof.

- 

Electric Hand Blower This is a very inexpensive blower. Gas and battery operated ones also work great but cleaning tools don't need to break the bank to work properly.

- 

Garbage Bags You will want to buy bags specifically marked as "contractor bags". These bags are stronger and bigger that you can trust not to break while you are up on your roof.
